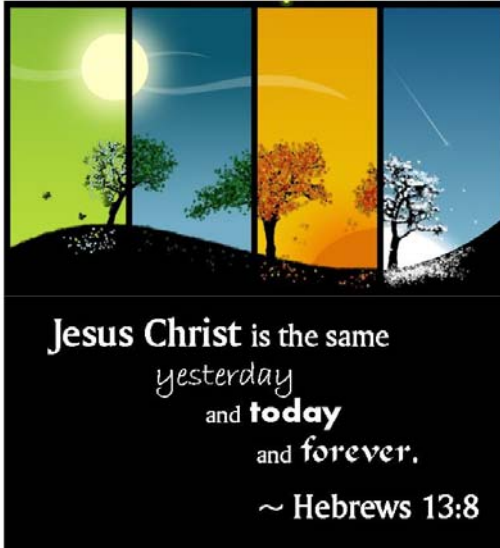


# Prowling About


