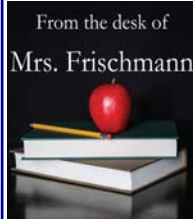
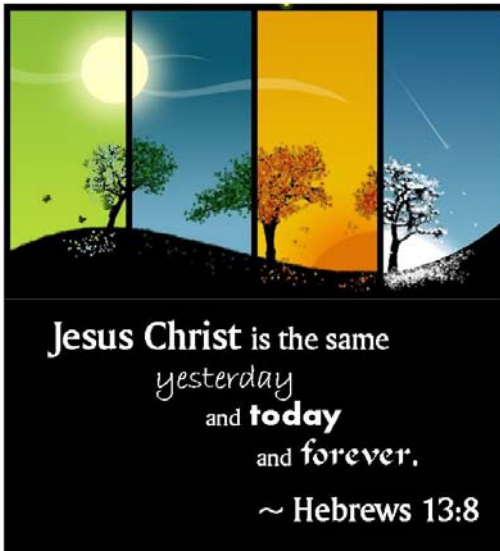


Prowling About

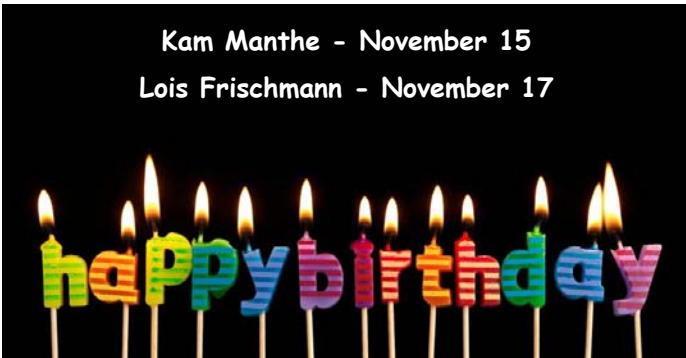
